Get Ready for Barossa CLW 2025




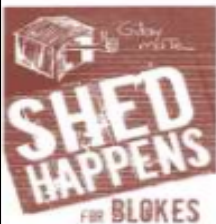
Barossa CLW is back - and we are more excited than ever!

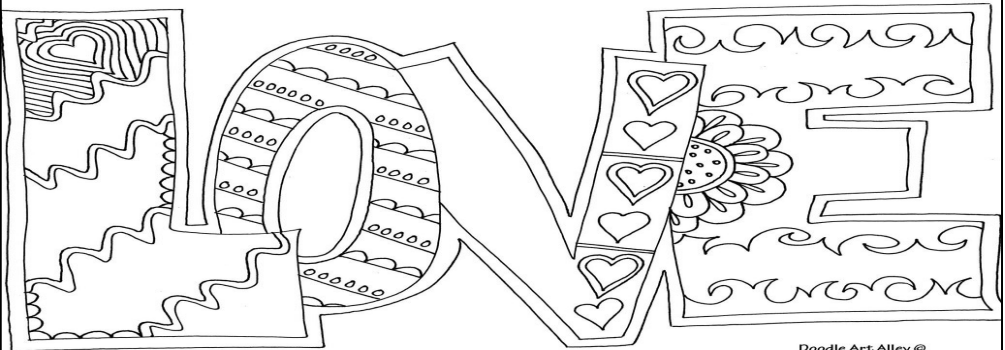

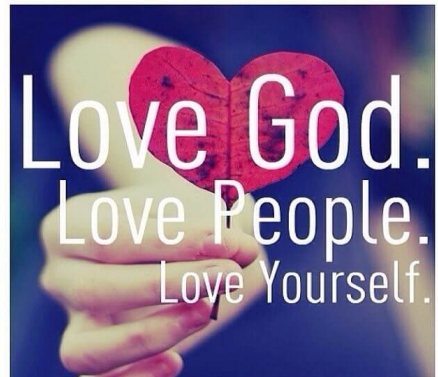
