Barossa Ark has a great range of items that inspire and affirm, that encourage, comfort and build-up when life invariably becomes tougher and more difficult.



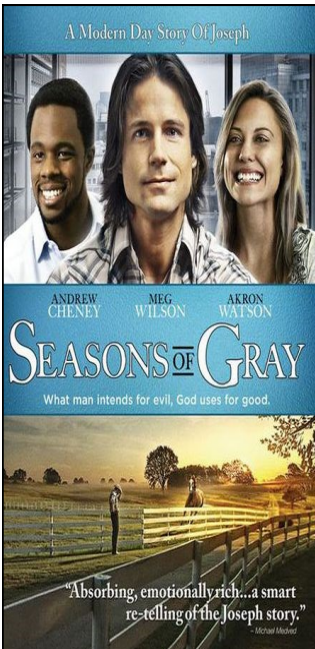

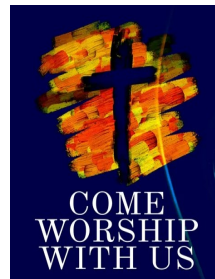
