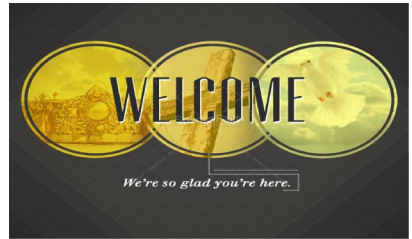

Retiring offering at the end of the service: to support the local farming community.

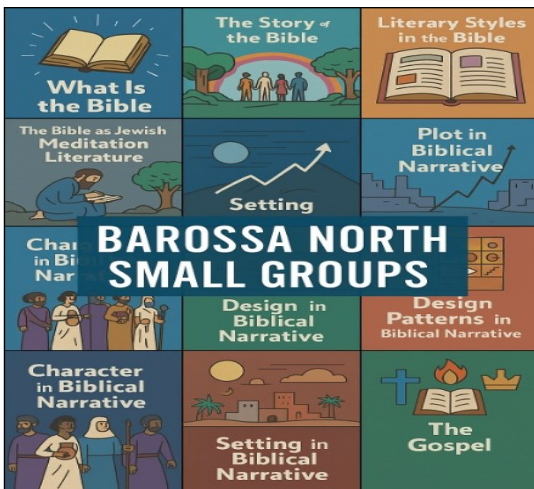
NOW Service: God's Gentle Whisper

Barossa CLW is a Christian camp aimed at Year 7-12 students held at Cornerstone College in the July school holidays, between the 7-11th of July.

Camp offers so many fun things for our young people to get engaged with. There are awesome electives such as sport, music, art and bible deep dives, as well as a service elective this year where we get to practice what it means to give back. We play games, engage in team building activities, small group time, eat incredible food, have the opportunity to make new friends and of course we learn about Jesus through worship and bible study time. CLW is an opportunity for young people to learn about Jesus in a fun, encouraging environment with other believers from their local region.

This year we are exploring the theme of Illuminate, delving into Jesus being the perfect example of light but what it means to live in the light, believe in things we cannot see and stay plugged into the source of the light all year round. We are debunking big life questions and exploring big Christian terms like grace and forgiveness and what they mean for young people today.

Ruth and Richard's account of their recent overseas trip

We had an extraordinary time in the meeting room last weekend. We listened to Ruth and Richard's account of their recent overseas trip to central Asia.

Glenda and Pastor Andy Kowald were unexpected visitors in the near full meeting room. Ruth and Richard have enjoyed taking the Gospel to people who have not heard it. I suspect we can learn a great deal from these people.

Ruth opened their report with a broad sweeping statement that acknowledged God's gracious goodness and sustaining power throughout their four-week journey as they travelled, met, taught, ate and drank, celebrated, laughed and cried with their Muslim friends halfway across the world.

Richard then filled in some detail as their four weeks unfolded ... some plans came into fruition, some didn't. Other opportunities opened up along the way for unexpected, spontaneous visits, meetings, reunions and gatherings. As one listener commented ... *"what we're hearing today sounds a bit like the book of Acts"*.

Looking around the room at the conclusion of their reporting time over a cuppa, I couldn't help but take in the overall feelings of calmness, joy, quiet excitement and amazement of God's activity.

Richard foreshadowed a follow-on opportunity where he and Ruth are happy to take us a little deeper into sharing the Gospel - we'll do this in July, with more details to follow.
