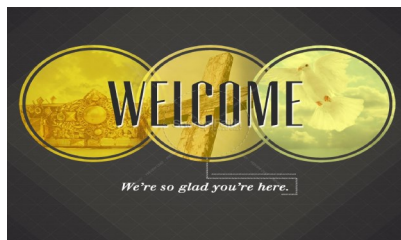

Retiring offering at the end of the service: to support the local farming community.

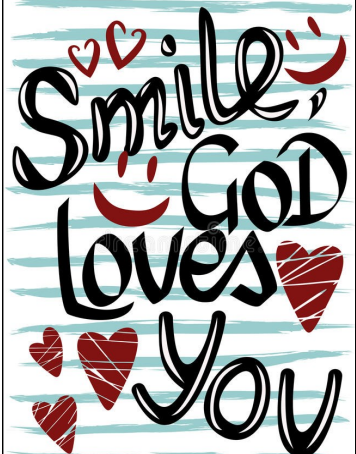

Run, don't walk because Barossa CLW registrations are now open!

Barossa CLW is a Christian camp aimed at Year 7-12 students held at Cornerstone College in the July school holidays, between the 7-11th of July.

Camp offers so many fun things for our young people to get engaged with. There are awesome electives such as sport, music, art and bible deep dives, as well as a service elective this year where we get to practice what it means to give back. We play games, engage in team building activities, small group time, eat incredible food, have the opportunity to make new friends and of course we learn about Jesus through worship and bible study time. CLW is an opportunity for young people to learn about Jesus in a fun, encouraging environment with other believers from their local region.

This year we are exploring the theme of Illuminate, delving into Jesus being the perfect example of light but what it means to live in the light, believe in things we cannot see and stay plugged into the source of the light all year round. We are debunking big life questions and exploring big Christian terms like grace and forgiveness and what they mean for young people today.

At the next Mission Moments, Pastor Richard will share some further insight on conversations with those who are growing in faith in Jesus or are yet to hear about Jesus.

Richard says there are two simple and profound rules of 'people-fishing':

1. Go to where the 'fish' are; go to the unreached or least-reached people groups.
2. Use the 'bait' that the 'fish' respond to, e.g. what worked for Europeans in the 16th Century may not be relevant to Asians in the 21st Century.

The 'friendship project', initiated in 2005 with Pastor Andy and Glenda Kowald, started with this perspective amongst the Crimean Tartars. Over time, various 'baits' have been fine-tuned to spark curiosity and interest in Jesus our Saviour. The universal acceptance of 'the idea of fate' is an underlying factor which also resonated with this group of Muslim people.





The next Mission Moments on Sunday the 13th of July, will examine several case stories of how these elements were used in Ruth and Richard's recent overseas trip.

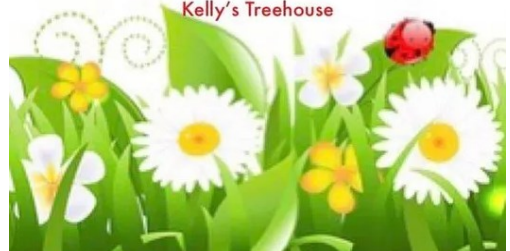

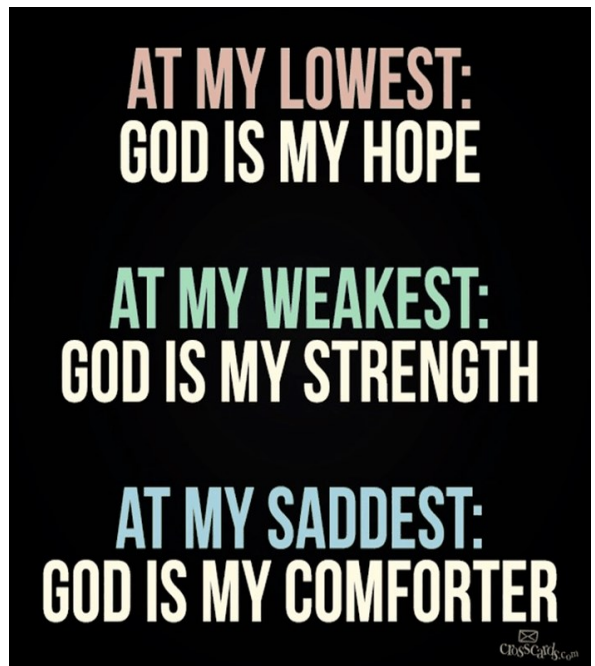
