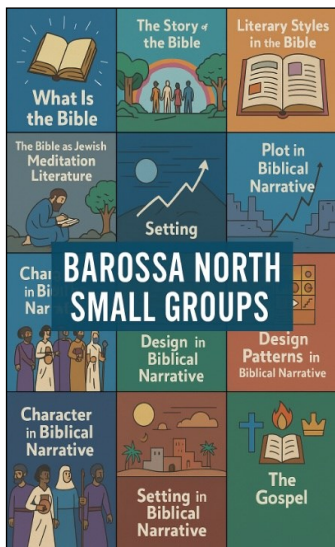

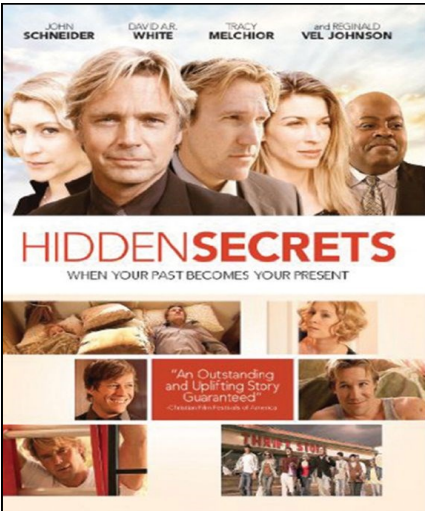

## **An update from the LLL Board**

I am writing to advise that the Board has accepted the resignation of our Chief Executive Officer, Ross Smith. Ross is returning to live and work in Sydney for personal reasons.

The Board commends Ross for his outstanding leadership over the past five years. He leaves LLL in August with the organisation in a solid financial position as we continue to fulfil our purpose to advance Gospel-centred mission and ministry.

Assuming the role in November 2020, Ross has guided LLL through some of the most significant changes in our history, including the transition from an Authorised Deposit-taking Institution (ADI) to a Religious Charitable Development Fund (RCDF).

Ross has ensured we are well positioned to continue to be Australia's leading charitable financial institution.

The Board has endorsed a strategic growth agenda and we look forward to expanding our loans and investments into the future.

While we regret that Ross is leaving, we understand and fully support his decision.

A national recruitment process for the next Chief Executive Officer of LLL will commence shortly and we look forward to sharing news on this appointment when made.

In the meantime, I am pleased to announce that LLL Board Director Karen Pienaar will be interim CEO. Karen is a C-suite leader with eminent experience in the not-for-profit, transport and defence sectors. She is also the congregational Treasurer of Bethlehem Lutheran Church – Flinders St, Adelaide. Karen is a familiar face at LLL's office and will take on this role full-time.
