Saturday June 27th at Immanuel LP Church Hall from 9:00am until 12:30pm.

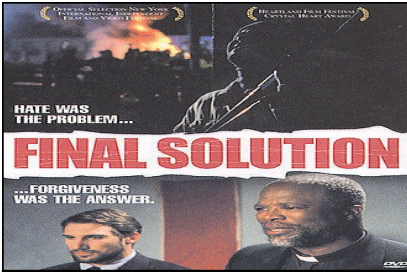
Discover how to share your faith confidently and naturally, turning everyday interactions into meaningful faith conversations.

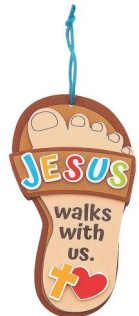

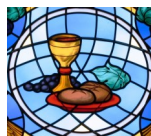
