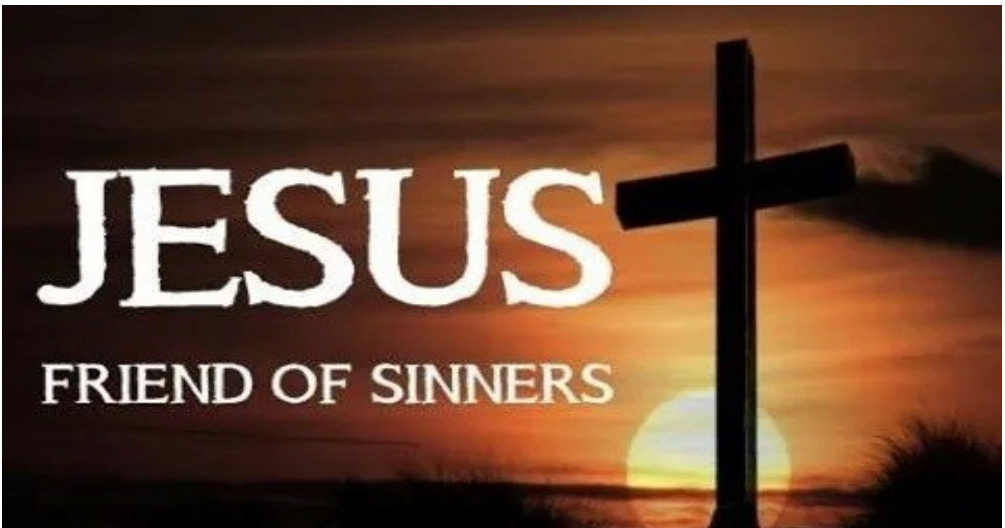

- 3 Not already receiving support from federal programs such as the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) or My Aged Care.

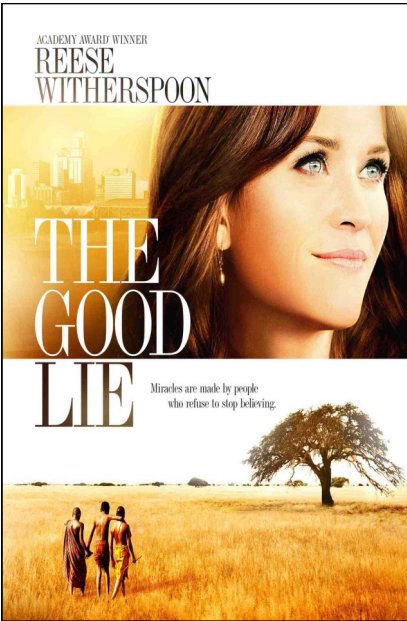
