Sadder news this week and a week that didn't go as planned

Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord...Rev 14:13

The young adult son of one of our lecturers died on campus last week after an illness of 8 months. We assisted the family for the body to be taken to the funeral home. We shared in worship every night with the family, and received mourners to the campus during the day.

Lectures were cancelled for the week.



The body was received back at the seminary. We held a worship service with the family and the seminary transported the body to the family village. The family gifted a pig to the seminary; we slaughtered and cooked it in a ground oven / "mumu" style the next day and shared with the whole seminary community.

Please pray for our lecturer Pastor Matthew Doa and family in their sorrow and for our seminary community as it returns to class.
