Heidi has been learning and teaching German language and culture for over 30 years. She has extensive experience in Language Curriculum and Assessment, having worked with the C2C Project in Queensland (Languages) and with SACE Board over many years. She is an accredited Goethe Institute examiner (A1-C2). Her doctoral thesis connected the areas of German Studies, Linguistics and Language revival, and explored the linguistic legacy of Lutheran missionaries in 19th century South Australia.

LCA International Mission Update

LCA International Mission partners with churches in our neighbouring countries to share the wonderful forgiveness and hope promised through the grace of God the Father, by the Son, through the Holy Spirit. As we partner, you can join us to proclaim and receive Jesus' love through volunteering. Volunteering to serve God overseas can be life-changing for you and the people you serve. Serving others in another country and being a living example of God's word, is faith in action which can produce incredible fruit for the Gospel. The two current most pressing volunteer needs are:

Online English Teaching Support for the Lutheran Church in Cambodia (LCC)

The purpose of LCC teaching English is to open doors for the gospel to be shared through the teachers showing their students Christ-like love and to build deeper relationships with the church and non-believers. Although the LCC English teachers are enthusiastic and invested in this ministry, most do not have teaching degrees and have requested mentorship as they serve.

We will therefore be running a 10 week online English program, for one hour every Saturday, beginning on the 13th of April. Volunteers will be supplied the curriculum used by LCC English teachers and will offer advice on how to improve the methodology and implement new methods if necessary to improve teaching quality and student learning outcomes.

Library Support for the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Papua New Guinea (ELC-PNG)

ELC-PNG seminary libraries are seeking the assistance of volunteers with librarian experience to develop and manage a system to file and organise the collection of books located in their libraries. Accompany a former librarian who is currently living in Melbourne as she develops consistency among the libraries and sets up an online cataloguing system in each of the seminaries.

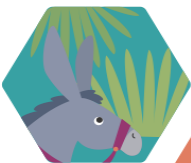

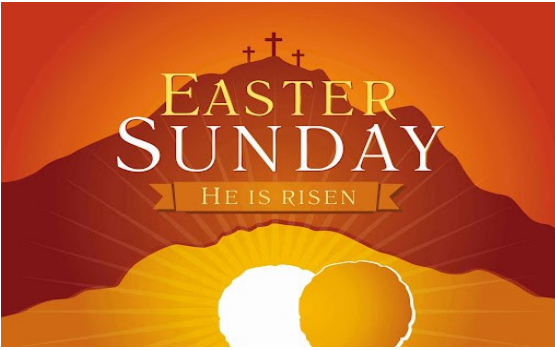
