



#### **Parish Council Meeting Report**

The Barossa North Parish Council held their first meeting for 2024 last Tuesday, the 2nd of April.

New members were welcomed - Naomi Todd from Ebenezer and Jenny Hartwig from Immanuel LP. Jenny was an apology as she was heading overseas to Japan. Roger Frahn led devotion asking for Gods grace on our meeting.

A considerable amount of time was spent in discussion on our Parish worship given that the celebration of Easter was fresh in our minds but also worship in general. The discussion highlighted that we all want the same things for our congregations but the ways to achieve all the differing opinions is taking time and not without its challenges. Not everyone's requests are going to be met. It was decided to keep the item of Parish worship/pastor/pastors on the agenda for the next meeting. This will give Parish council members a chance to think about these items and to be able to contribute to the discussion when we have Pastor Damien present at our next meeting (he was not present due to being on annual leave).

In the meantime, the Review Committee has their next meeting on the 18th of April. We ask for patience and understanding to give the Review Committee time to work through the points that have been identified.

#### Barossa Christian Life Week - Catering Support

It is that time of the year again and Barossa CLW 2024 is fast approaching! This means we are on the hunt yet again for some fabulous volunteers who would consider stepping into the kitchen to support our young people and make camp possible!

Barossa CLW for those of you who don't know about us, is a high school aged Christian camp that runs for 5 days in the July school holidays. It aims to bring young people together from all over the Barossa region from various congregations and denominations, and unite them to learn about God. This years camp is running from the 8th to 12th of July and is being hosted at Cornerstone College, Mount Barker.

#### So, what am I really asking? What a great question!


One of the biggest components of running a successful camp, is running a successful kitchen .... and we need helpers to make that possible. We have roughly 50-70 campers each year, plus a leadership team and extra volunteers that make up our 110ish people to feed.

We are specifically looking for someone willing to **run our kitchen** for the week - Be the head honcho! This means overseeing the kitchen and it's activities as well as managing meal times, food prep, meal service and coordinating with our camp directors and leadership team to facilitate a smooth running of the day. Whilst I appreciate that this sounds like a big task, we have put measures in place that all of the food will be purchased for you prior to camp and all of the recipes, quantities, daily schedules and plans will be provided for you. This means we purely need your assistance on camp, no prior prep work required.

However, if the kitchen lead is not your ideal role, we are also seeking busy-bee helpers to be our **kitchenhands** throughout the week. Over the past few years, we have structured this as day teams, having 5-8 people come into the kitchen every day and follow the instructions of the Kitchen Leader to ensure the days jobs get completed! Jobs involved include prepping food, cooking food, serving food to the young people (the best part), cleaning, packing up and of course, fellowship with our servant hearted people in our community! You may like to assist for just 1 day, or 2 or 3. We would love to have you!

If this sounds like something you would be keen to do or you know of someone who may be perfect for this type of role, please pray about this and get in touch with myself about the potential of having you serve on Barossa CLW for 2024. I really look forward to hearing from you.
